

**Topic:** Easter

**Resources:** an instruction card with an illustration of a Lego Duplo model (one of 464, 465, 466); six green large plates; brick selection sheet (ver. 7)



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### Activities:

1. The teacher gives each child an instruction card and an illustrated sheet for selecting bricks.
2. The child looks at the card and notes on the brick selection sheet the type and number of bricks needed to build the model. If necessary, the teacher helps.
3. Each child gives the brick selection sheet to another child so that all children exchange lists.
4. The children choose bricks from the storage boxes according to their selection list.
5. Each child gives the bricks they chose to the child who gave him the list.
6. The child assembles the model with the bricks they received.
7. Each child shows their model, explains what they built, who gave them the bricks and how the model is related to the Easter holiday. If a model did not work, the child explains why (with the help of the teacher if necessary).
8. The children, with their teacher, conclude that each of the models can be built with bricks of the same type but a different color; and this provides greater variety.
9. The children all build an Easter Garden on large green plates using the models they have made.
